SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

General Information

The William C. Ehrhardt, Jr. Memorial Scholarship has been created to honor the memory of William "Bubba" Ehrhardt who worked tirelessly for Catholic education as a whole and especially for Cardinal Newman School. Whether working in the forefront, as president of the Cardinal Club, or within the community heralding the qualities of Catholic schools, his dedication and presence will not soon be replaced.

These memorial scholarships were established in gratitude and love for "Bubba" and his family for their many years of service to the Cardinal Newman family. These annual merit-based scholarships will provide deserving students the opportunity for a quality Catholic education and to develop the attributes for which "Bubba" is remembered. Ehrhardt scholars will carry on the legacy of commitment, friendship, and loyalty left by "Bubba".

This merit-based scholarship grants four (4) \$1,000 awards to Scholarship recipients.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ Student may be new or returning registered Cardinal Newman students.
- ◆ Students must be good in academic and disciplinary standing prior to and throughout the scholarship period (Failure to remain in good standing will prevent recipients from reapplying).
- ◆ Students must have maintained a 3.0 GPA or equivalent.
- ◆ Students must be actively involved in school life and the community.
- ◆ Catholic and non-Catholic students whose family is **actively** involved and in good standing with a Catholic parish or school.

Application:

- ◆ All applications must be submitted no later than **NOON** on **MARCH 15, 2010**. No late applications will be considered.
- ◆ Application will include teacher or sponsor recommendation.
- ◆ A 300-500 word essay must be submitted. The essay topic is: "The Importance of a Catholic/Christian Education."
- ◆ A personal interview will be required of scholarship finalist.

Application Process:

February

- ◆ Applications and information distributed to current Cardinal Newman students and other interested parish affiliated students.

March

- ◆ **COMPLETED APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE BEFORE OR BY NOON ON MARCH 15, 2009**

April and May

- ◆ Committee meets to evaluate candidates
- ◆ Scholarships awarded at the final Mass of the School year. Award winner's names put on plaques.
